Dallas Bomber Pleads Guilty

Hosam Maher Husein Smadi pleaded guilty on Wednesday to trying

to bomb an office building in Dallas, Texas.

In September 2009, Smadi drove a truck to the building. The truck

contained a homemade bomb. He left it in the parking garage and

turned on its timer.

Smadi then met with another person who drove him away. From a

distance, he tried to set off the bomb with his cell phone.

There were two things he didn't know. First, though the bomb was

real, it was inert (not working). Second, the person "helping" him

was really a government agent.

The court says Smadi acted alone, not as a member of a terrorist

group.

Smadi, who is 19, could be sent to prison for life. Since he agreed to

plead guilty, he may get 30 years instead.
