

## **Guilty Plea from Man Who Used Different ID's**

Jeremy Clark-Erskine has pleaded guilty to aggravated ID theft, forging a judge's signature, taking a stolen car between States, and using another person's Social Security number.

If the case had gone to court, the U.S. government says it would have proved that Clark-Erskine:

- tried to get a Montana driver's license under the name Angus Jocko Ferguson
- used someone else's Social Security number for this
- forged a judge's signature to get another Social Security number
- rented a car for one day, but then drove it from Montana to California
- tried to get onto a military base by posing as an Army officer
- used several different names.
