

Pakistani Student Sentenced for Plans to Support Taliban

A Pakistani who went to the U.S. on a student visa has been sent to prison for 15 years. He has been found guilty of planning to send money to the Taliban, and illegally owning a gun.

Adan Mirza was living in Houston, Texas. He went to a community college. On weekends, he and others went camping to practice using guns. They were training for a jihad (Muslim war).

Mirza and the others planned to send money to the Taliban. He also had a gun, which is illegal for foreign students living in the U.S.
