

Warplanes Called Out During Trouble on Airline Flight

A flight from Portland, Oregon, to Hawaii turned back on Wednesday because of a passenger's behavior. Two F-15 fighter planes met the plane and flew back with it.

The FBI says the man was acting in a way that made the crew "concerned". The pilot decided to turn back.

The man and a woman traveling with him were taken off the plane. They were questioned by police and the FBI. But they were not charged with any crime.

The F-15s belong to the Oregon Air National Guard. It guards the air from Northern California to Canada.
